


Below is a list of everything you need to set up the MyCareLink Heart mobile app:



- Your smartphone or tablet. Please ensure that your mobile device is sufficiently charged. Medtronic recommends that it is at least 50% charged.
- Your Google Play[™] account and password. If you have trouble accessing the Play Store, visit <u>Google Support</u>.
- A valid email address.
- Your heart device serial number, which can be found on your patient ID card. If you have trouble finding this information, call Medtronic Stay Connected Service at 1-800-929-4043.

Please visit MCLHeart.com for a list of compatible devices.

The requirements for your mobile device and OS version will change over time. You may need to update or replace your mobile device and OS to use the app to transfer data between your heart device and the Medtronic CareLink™ network. All patient and clinician data is fictitious and for demonstration purposes only.

Step 1: Scan QR code


From your mobile device, scan the QR code or visit MCLheart.com/download. If you are not taken directly to the Google Play store, tap on the Google Play badge.





Step 2: Check compatibility

- If your mobile device is compatible, you can tap "INSTALL" to download the app.
- If your mobile device is not compatible, you will see "Your device isn't compatible with this version." Please speak with your clinician about other monitoring options.




Step 3: Download

Once downloaded, the MyCareLink Heart mobile app icon will appear on your mobile device screen. Look for this icon and tap to open.

Note: MyCareLink Heart is a free app. Please visit <u>Google Support</u> if you are having trouble downloading it from Google Play.

The MyCareLink HeartTM Application ("Licensed Application") is provided by Medtronic, Inc. ("Medtronic") to monitor and transmit data from a Medtronic implanted heart device ("Heart Device") to the Medtronic CareLink® Network ("CareLink Network") via a mobile device. The Licensed Application can be used by a patient that has been prescribed the Licensed Application by a physician ("Patient"). The Licensed Application may also allow a Patient to enter information into a journal within the Licensed Application, including symptoms or other medical information ("Symptom Journal"). The Symptom Journal In addition, the Licensed Application may allow for collection of certain information about the Patient-e.g., weight, blood pressure, and/or heart rate ("Vitals Tracking") via manual entry by the Patient. 
Pairing may take three to six minutes and the first transmission might take up to three hours. During transmission, you must keep your mobile device within three feet/one meter of your heart device.






